Take the quick class on SAFE FOOD HANDLING .

There is a quick test that you can take online which results in a certificate.

All volunteers who are handling food should have this certificate.

The class takes 90 minutes including the test at the end.

The test requires 70% to pass

The certificate costs \$7.50 and the church can reimburse you for the fee.

On the day of volunteering:

11:00 a.m. Help kitchen manager plate salads and desserts quickly.

See if coffee or drinks need replenishing.

Help Lunch Bunch find seats that are socially distant

(no more than 2 per small table and 4 per large table)

Program Manager or Parish Nurse handles money and sign-ins

11:30 a.m. Serve salads.

Kitchen manager will plate hot dishes while you serve salad.

When they are finished with salads, help to serve hot plates.

Remove salad dishes.

Help with scraping and washing of dishes

Remove main dish plates

Serve desserts.

You may eat with the seniors if you like. If there are many seniors present, please wait to see if there will be enough food to

Help pick up dessert plates, kitchen cleanup and sanitizing tables.

Most days another staff is around to help: Parish Nurse on Tuesday and Thursday. Program Manager on other days.
